HACC PYP supports Victorians from birth to 65 years (Aboriginal people from birth to 50 years) to optimise their health and wellbeing, whilst maintaining or regaining their independence to live safely in their homes.

HACC PYP services also allow people to actively participate in their community. These services are delivered from multiple sites across metropolitan Melbourne and regional Victoria.

We partner with our clients in the assessment and planning process to ensure they receive the care and support they need to achieve their goals. The objectives of the program are;

- To assist people to connect and engage in their communities
- To assist people to improve their health, and wellbeing
- To assist people to live as independently as possible.
