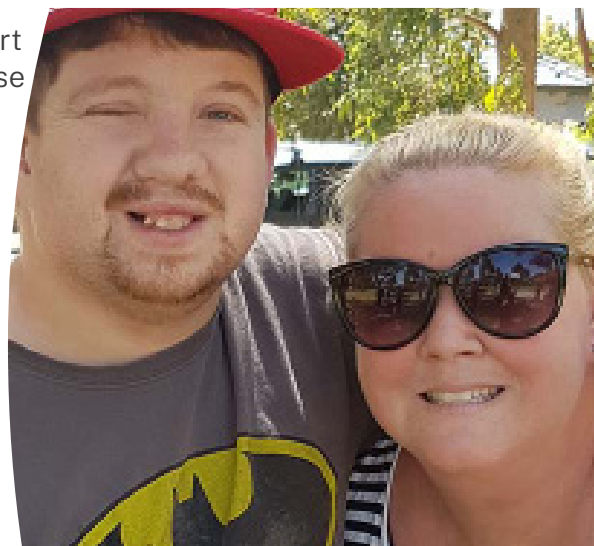
Our focus is on providing community inclusiveness and a strong support network for all of our clients, recognising and understanding the diverse needs, interests and abilities of all people.
