Residential room pricing information

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) or a combination of both. A RAD is paid as a lump sum amount. A DAP accrues daily and is paid monthly. A combination payment includes both RAD and DAP payments. The below prices have been approved by the Aged Care Pricing Commissioner.

All rooms are furnished with electronic high/low beds, bedside cabinets, built in wardrobes and nurse call buttons. Rooms are also heated with hydronic heating so residents can change the temperature in their room. Ceiling fans have also been installed for use in the warmer months.

mecwacare Long Gully has a separate dining and lounge area with large screen television which provide the residents with an area to socialise.

mecwacare Long Gully is surrounded by gardens with sitting areas and winding pathways.

Additional care or services included in the accommodation payment

An activities calendar is planned a month in advance and provides many interesting and varied group activities such as the cafe each Friday. Outings are conducted regularly using the facility bus to a variety of places of interest.

Residents also enjoy a gardening group, cooking and sewing classes, sing-alongs, dancing and music each week. Throughout the year regular volunteers, entertainers, community church groups and individuals offer their skills and time to the residents and staff of mecwacare Long Gully.

In addition to the costs associated with the room, mecwacare offers optional purchase of the services of qualified personal care staff, for example to accompany a resident on an outing such as shopping or a walk, or to provide additional care or companionship within the facility.
